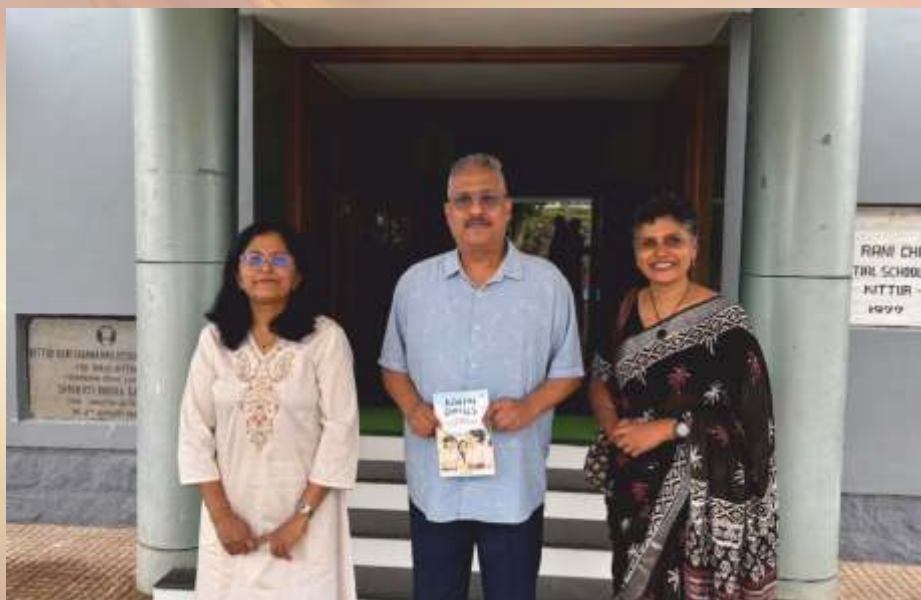
Founder Alumni Revisit Their Alma Mater
